## Conditions of Entry – Ag-Art Wear Competition

Entry to the competition is FREE. However LATE submissions may incur a \$20 processing fee.

These conditions of entry apply to all competition entrants.

- All entrants must complete the official 2-page entry form and forward to the Ag-Art Wear Coordinator, Penny Gill, by Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025; email: pennygill134@gmail.com. (This is your commitment to participate and necessary for organisers to coordinate entries).
- 2. The person/group named on the entry form must have created the garment. A maximum of 2 entries per designer will be accepted. When promoting this event, the Riverland Field Days Inc. holds the exclusive rights for all advertising and photos relevant to the Ag-Art Wear Competition.
- 3. AG-ART WEAR GARMENT: The creation and its accessories are to be made from material of an agricultural and/or horticultural nature as produced or found on a farm or block, however buttons, zips and such items may be used without penalty. Use of non-agricultural products such as household items, commercial dress fabric, hats, shoes etc. is allowed, however points will be deducted. Materials may be of new or used condition.
- 4. Up-CYCLED WEAR GARMENT: The creation and its accessories are to be made from products of a recycled/used nature. All materials/products used need not be of an agricultural/horticultural natural but must have served their purpose in their intended way and then reused to be given new life in the form of a piece of wearable art. You are only limited by your imagination and with the use of found materials/products, for example: milk cartons, coffee pods, tin cans, plastic bottles, packaging material etc. Points will be deducted for the use of new materials/products.
- 5. All garments to be from size 10 14 (adult women's and equivalent men's). Any garments outside these sizes will not be accepted.
- 6. The garment must allow free body movement and not injure, scratch or be of a hindrance to the wearer. It must be of a weight that can be comfortably worn and carried. Every garment must be able to pass through a standard doorway whilst being worn.
- 7. The creation must be durable enough to be worn at least twice under fashion parade conditions. All models are arranged by the Ag Art Coordinator.
- 8. Judging will be based on the imagination of the creator, the appearance, and the use of materials. The creation need not be practical, but rather entertaining and/or artistic.
- 9. Judging is on visual inspection. Judges do not examine the finish or seams of garments.
- 10. Entries will be judged in one of the following two age categories: **U/18 school students** and **Open Adult entries.**
- 11. The judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 12. Riverland Field Days "Ag-Art Wear" Competition judging will be held at the Riverland Field Day and the winners to be announced at the final parade on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2025. All designers are encouraged to attend the award presentation ceremony at the conclusion of the Saturday afternoon parade.
- 13. It is the responsibility of the entrant to **arrange delivery of the garment** to the Ag-Art Wear Coordinator Penny Gill by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025.** Any garments delivered after this date will not be eligible to compete unless other arrangements are made, and a \$20 late processing fee may be incurred.
- 14. Collection of garments after the event is between 4pm and 5pm on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2025 and is the responsibility of the entrants. If the garment is not collected it becomes the property of the Ag-Art Wear Competition, unless other arrangements are made with the Ag-Art Wear Coordinator. The organisers will not be responsible for any damage or loss of an entry.
- 15. The Committee reserves the right to amend the Conditions of Entry if deemed necessary prior to the event. Notification will be given as soon as possible following the amendment.
- 16. Entrants failing to comply with any of the above conditions may be excluded from the competition.
- 17. Entrants will be issued with a complimentary one-day pass to the Riverland Field Days Event.
- 18. Cash prize pool valued at \$1000.
